Industry Training Authority (ITA) Youth Train in Trades program objectives:

ITA Youth Train in Trades is an industry certification program for BC secondary school students. The program enables students to earn both graduation credits and credit for the first level of technical training associated with an ITA Program or apprenticeship. Through work experience placements, students can also earn credit towards the on-the-job component of an ITA Program. This is an opportunity for high school students to get a head start on earning their credentials in one of the more than



 $100\ \mathrm{trades}$ or industry occupations that are accredited or recognized by the Industry Training Authority.
