Tools & Materials:

- Hammer
- Safety Glasses
- 2" x 4" wood rectangle with nose cut @ 45° angle
- Sanding blocks
- Finishing Nails
- Stocking for a hat
- Sharpie Felt
- Googly Eyes and Pompom nose

I. Gather Materials



2. Using the sanding block
- sand all of the edges and
surfaces of the wood
block.



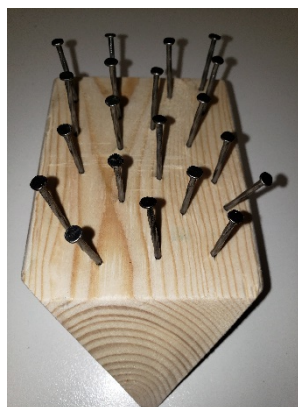
3. Once the wood square is sanded smooth, turn it over and write your name on the bottom using a sharpie felt.



4. Turn the block back over and carefully begin to hammer nails into the top. They should be spaced away from the edges. BE SURE TO WEAR YOUR SAFETY GLASSES.



5. Once your nails are in, check to ensure there are no nails that are loose and may fall out.



6. With help from an adult you can glue your eyes and nose onto the front of your hedgehog. You can also add the finishing touch of the stocking Hat. .
